



Office of Financial Aid Summer 2006 Aid Information

General Information

The Office of Financial Aid provides a variety of grant and loans to assist you with financing the cost of attending the College. Available sources of financial aid for Summer 2006 include:

- *Federal Stafford Student Loans
- *Federal Pell Grants
- *Parent Loans for Undergraduate Students

Students are advised that use of Federal Stafford Loans for the summer period may be limited if a student has used loan funds during the previous academic year. For example, if a student used their maximum eligibility of \$2625 as a freshman or \$3500 as a sophomore during the 2005-2006 academic year, this student may not have remaining eligibility during the 2006 summer sessions. The loan eligibility period runs from September 2005 through August 2006.

Additionally, if a student received a Federal Pell Grant for full time attendance (12 credit hours or more each term) during the 2005-06 academic year, this student would not be eligible for a summer Pell Grant. However, if a student attended less than full time for either the Fall or Spring semester, this student may be eligible for a summer Pell Grant award.

Application Information

File the following application forms by April 7th in order for you to receive your eligibility notice for summer aid before the beginning of summer classes.

1. File a **2005-2006 FAFSA** if you have not already done so, online at **www.fafsa.ed.gov** or complete a paper version of the FAFSA. **Our federal college code number is 003249.**
2. File a *Community College of Philadelphia 2006 Summer Financial Aid Application*
3. You must **register** at least half-time (6 credits between Sessions I and II) in order to be awarded summer loans. Eligibility will be determined for students who file an Application for Summer Financial Aid. However, you must be officially registered before aid can be awarded and disbursed.
