General Information: An agreement exists between the CCP Paralegal program and the Arcadia University Political Science major. If a student earns an AAS in Paralegal Studies at CCP, he/she transfers with junior standing to the Political Science major at Arcadia. Students must follow the Paralegal curriculum as described below. A 2.5 cumulative GPA must be earned. Arcadia accepts up to 75 transfer credits. The Arcadia political science major can only be completed during the day time. This agreement is intended to facilitate the transfer of Paralegal Studies students. Students in the CCP Liberal Arts curriculum are not required to switch to the Paralegal program to transfer into the Political Science major. Students in Liberal Arts should consult the Arcadia “Core” guide and complete POLS 111 within the context of the Liberal Arts degree. **Note: This guide is based on CCP degree requirements for students who entered the Paralegal curriculum through summer 2009. Students who enter the curriculum fall 2009 or after should consult paralegal curriculum advisors about curriculum changes.**
