General Information: This guide outlines an agreement between CCP and Arcadia University. If a student earns an A. A. in Business with at least a 2.5 GPA, he/she may transfer to a business major at Arcadia with junior standing. The agreement covers the Arcadia majors of a B. A. or B. S. in Accounting, B. A. or B. S. in Business Administration with a concentration in Finance, Human Resources Administration, Management, Management Information Systems or Marketing, or the B. A. in Health Administration. Students should consult Mr. Davis above about possible CCP curriculum changes. This agreement is based on the CCP Business curriculum in effect for students admitted to the curriculum until Fall 2009.
