General Information: An agreement exists between CCP and Arcadia. A student who earns an AA in Communication Arts—Speech transfers with junior standing to the Communications program at Arcadia. A 2.5 cumulative GPA must be earned. Only grades of “C” or higher are accepted. Arcadia accepts up to 75 credits. **Note: CCP has changed its general requirement for students who begin in the curriculum in Fall 2009. Consult with Communication Arts curriculum advisors for updated information.**
