General Information: THE FOLLOWING IS AN OUTLINE OF AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN CCP AND ARCADIA UNIVERSITY. IF A STUDENT EARNS AN A.A. DEGREE IN EDUCATION BY FOLLOWING THE GUIDELINES BELOW, HE/SHE TRANSFERS TO ARCADIA WITH JUNIOR STANDING. AT LEAST A 2.5 GPA IS REQUIRED. IT IS IMPORTANT TO NOTE THAT THE STATE OF PENNSYLVANIA, THROUGH CHAPTER 354, HAS INCREASED GPA REQUIREMENTS FOR STUDENT ADMISSION AND PERSISTANCE IN TEACHER CERTIFICATION PROGRAMS. TO BE ADMITTED TO THE PROFESSIONAL SEQUENCE IN TEACHER EDUCATION, STUDENTS MUST EARN A 3.0 GPA. STUDENTS MAY BE ADMITTED TO ARCADIA WITH LESS THAN THE STATE MANDATED GPA, BUT THEY WILL NEED TO EARN THE APPROPRIATE GPA AT ARCADIA. STUDENTS MUST ALSO TAKE THE PRAXIS TEST I: PRE-PROFESSIONAL SKILLS TESTS IN ORDER TO BE ADMITTED TO THE PROFESSIONAL SEQUENCE. CCP EDUCATION ADVISORS SHOULD BE CONSULTED ABOUT THE GPA REQUIREMENTS AND THE PRAXIS TEST. **Note: The PA Dept. of Education is stipulating changes in requirements for teacher certification programs at four-year institutions. Consult with Education curriculum advisors for updates.**
