**General Information:** An agreement exists between CCP and Arcadia. A student who earns an AA in Communication Arts—Theater transfers with junior standing to the Theater Arts program at Arcadia. A 2.5 cumulative GPA must be earned. Only grades of “C” or higher are accepted. Arcadia accepts up to 75 credits. **Note: This guide is based on CCP degree requirements for students who entered the Communication Arts--Theater curriculum through summer 2009. Students who enter the curriculum fall 2009 or after should consult communications curriculum advisors about curriculum changes.**
