2 programs offered: Transfers from DMI program (advanced placement) and Radiologic Sciences Multi-Competency (radiog. & ultrasound) - those with no prior experience in ultrasound or radiography. Multicompetency program is a full time day 24-month program, including summers. See Jefferson Advising Manual for full range of competency programs.

Advanced placement programs are offered on a full-time basis for 12 months. **It is important that students read the Jefferson Advising Manual for a full range of program options. (Also highly recommend observation work and/or volunteer experience in either radiography or ultrasound, but it is not required).**

CCP has signed an affiliate agreement with TJU. The affiliate agreement states that if a student completes all prerequisite courses with at least a 2.7 cumulative GPA, and submits two letters of recommendation (one from a personal, professional or academic source and one from Mr. Peter Baratta, Assistant to the Dean for Math, Science and Health Careers at CCP, the student is admitted to TJU provided that there is space in the program. Before the Mr. Baratta makes a final recommendation, a student must be in the final stages of completing the program prerequisites and must arrange an interview with Mr. Baratta. To arrange an interview, please call 215-751-8438. At the interview, a student should provide to Mr. Baratta a brief biographical summary or resume. Even though the minimum GPA required is 2.7, TJU recommends at least a 3.0, and the dean must agree that the student is qualified for admission to TJU. Students with disciplinary or criminal records are excluded from a guarantee of admission. Students are recommended to apply to Jefferson at least 3 months prior to the desired term of enrollment at TJU. **Students in the CCP Diagnostic Imaging Program should consult with Department Chair Sally Rensch in regard to transfer.**
