**General Information:** The following outlines an agreement between CCP and PSU-Delaware County. If a student earns an A.A. degree in Education at CCP with a cumulative GPA of at least 2.5, he/she transfers to PSU with third year status. Students must take the specific course requirements below for the agreement to take effect. To be admitted to the professional sequence in teacher education, students must earn a 3.0 cumulative GPA. Students must also take the PRAXIS Test I: Pre-professional Skills Tests. in order to be admitted to the professional sequence. CCP education advisors should be consulted about the gpa requirements and the PRAXIS Test.
