<b>General Information: CCP and Rosemont have an agreement which states that students who earn an AA in Education—Elementary Option from CCP with at least a 2.75 cumulative GPA are admitted to Rosemont with junior standing. However, the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania stipulates that all students must earn a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0 to be admitted to the sequence of professional courses that lead to student teaching. Students may be admitted to Rosemont with less than a 3.0 GPA but must earn a 3.0 at Rosemont to enter the professional sequence. The grid below shows how the requirements of the CCP degree program transfer to Rosemont.</b>
