**General Information:** This agreement facilitates the transfer of CCP students who have earned an AAS in ESL/English Interpreting to Rosemont College’s Sociology—Deaf Studies Track major. Students who earn at least a cumulative 2.5 GPA are automatically accepted to Rosemont. Students who earn between a 2.0 and 2.49 are covered by the agreement, but their acceptance is contingent on space availability at Rosemont. Junior status is awarded AAS graduates. Courses in which a grade of “D” is earned are accepted for core or elective requirements. The major department determines if “D” grades count for the major. Rosemont is a women’s college.
