General Information: The following outlines an agreement between CCP and Universidad del Sagrado Corazon in Santurce, Puerto Rico. Students who complete the A.A. in Education – Elementary Option from CCP, as listed below, with a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher will be assured junior status at Sagrado. This will allow full time students to complete the requirements for the Bachelor Degree in four regular semesters. Only grades of a 2.0 (C) average or above will be accepted in transfer. Courses at Sagrado are taught in Spanish. Students wishing to attend must be proficient in Spanish. To meet this requirement, students may take the Spanish proficiency test administered by the Foreign language Department at CCP or take the CLEP exam administered by the College Board. Enrollment at Sagrado must occur within ten years of graduation from CCP. Students must also obtain a letter of recommendation from the Dean of Students at Community College of Philadelphia as a part of their application.
