**General Information:** THE FOLLOWING OUTLINES AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN CCP AND ST. JOSEPH'S. IF A STUDENT EARNS AN ASSOCIATE IN ARTS DEGREE IN EDUCATION AT CCP, HE/SHE WILL TRANSFER WITH JUNIOR STANDING TO THE ELEMENTARY EDUCATION PROGRAM AT SJU. STUDENTS MUST EARN A 2.5 GPA FOR THE AGREEMENT TO TAKE EFFECT.. **IT IS IMPORTANT TO NOTE THAT THE STATE OF PENNSYLVANIA, THROUGH CHAPTER 354, HAS INCREASED GPA REQUIREMENTS FOR STUDENT ADMISSION AND PERSISTENCE IN TEACHER CERTIFICATION PROGRAMS. FOR ACADEMIC YEAR 2003-2004 AND AFTER, 3.0 GPA IS NEEDED TO ENTER THE PROFESSIONAL SEQUENCE OF TEACHER CERTIFICATION COURSES . STUDENTS ALSO MUST TAKE THE PRAXIS TEST I: PRE-PROFESSIONAL SKILLS TESTS IN ORDER TO BE ADMITTED TO TEACHER EDUCATION. STUDENTS CAN BE ADMITTED TO THE UNIVERSITY WITHOUT THE PRAXIS, BUT THEY WILL NEED TO SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETE THE TEST BEFORE OFFICIAL ADMISSION TO THE TEACHER PREPARATION PROGRAM. CCP EDUCATION ADVISORS SHOULD BE CONSULTED ABOUT GPA REQUIREMENTS AND THE PRAXIS TEST.**

**Note: This guide is based on CCP degree requirements for students who entered the Education curriculum through summer 2009. Students who enter the curriculum fall 2009 or after should consult education curriculum advisors about curriculum changes.**
