

Affiliation Agreement with Temple University, Japan Campus

Based on both institutions' commitment to international education, Community College of Philadelphia (CCP) and Temple University, Japan Campus (TUJ) have an agreement to facilitate the process of CCP students transferring to and studying at TUJ to earn a bachelor degree. Programs of study offered at TUJ are American Studies (major/minor), Art (major/minor), Asian Business and Society (certificate), Asian Studies (major/minor), Business Administration (minor/major from Fall 2007), Communications (major), Economics (major/minor), General Studies (major—interdisciplinary major in either humanities or social science), Geography and Urban Studies (minor), International Affairs (major), Japanese Language (minor/certificate), Political Science (major/minor), Psychological Studies (major/minor), and Tourism and Hospitality Management (major).

The agreement provides for the following:

1. waives the application fee for CCP students and provides admission decisions within three weeks of the submission of a complete application,
2. ensures that qualified students are considered for TUJ scholarships and other aid, prior to and after enrolling at TUJ,
3. provides preferential access to home-stay and dormitory housing, and
4. articulates courses that can be counted toward Temple University degrees.
