**General Information:** The following outlines an agreement between CCP and Temple’s College of Education. If a CCP student earns an A.A. in Education, he/she transfers to Temple with junior standing. The agreement stipulates that students must complete the requirements below with at least a 2.5 cumulative GPA. **It is important to note that the State of Pennsylvania, through Chapter 354, has increased GPA requirements for student admission and persistence in teacher certification programs. In order to implement the requirement, Temple requires a 3.0 cumulative GPA to gain entry into professional teacher education courses. Students also must take the PRAXIS Test I: Pre-professional Skills Tests in order to be admitted to teacher education. Students can be admitted to the University without the PRAXIS, but they will need to successfully complete the test before official admission to the teacher preparation program.** CCP education advisors should be consulted about GPA requirements and the PRAXIS test. Students enrolled in the education curriculum are eligible for the **dual admissions** agreement. The agreement provides students with a special admissions process and awards scholarships to students who earn at least a 3.0 GPA. Pick up a dual admissions information form from the Career and Transfer Center bulletin board or in the Office of Educational Support Services (W1-1). The dual admissions agreement stipulates that students must satisfy all requirements for the associate degree.
