<b>General Information:</b> CCP and West Chester have entered into an agreement. The agreement enables a CCP student who earns the AAS in Early Childhood Education to earn a West Chester BS in Education within four regular semesters and one summer session. This timeframe to earn the BS assumes full-time status at WCU. For the agreement to take effect, the CCP graduate must earn at least a 2.8 cumulative GPA and earn a grade of at least “C” in courses that are education core courses. The student must earn a 3.0 GPA by completion of the BS to qualify for Pennsylvania teacher certification. It is also required that students achieve passing scores on the Praxis I Pre-professional Skills Test by the end of the student’s first semester at WCU (It is recommended that students take Praxis before transfer.).
