General Information: A student who completes the A.A. in Education at Community College of Philadelphia is assured junior status in West Chester University’s B.S. Ed. In Elementary Education. A student must earn passing scores on the Praxis I Pre-professional Skills Test and achieve a minimum 2.8 gpa to qualify for admission to the B.S.Ed. Starting in Fall 2003, a student can be admitted to WCU with a 2.8 gpa, but must earn a gpa of at least 3.0 by the completion of the baccalaureate program to attain Pennsylvania certification.
