- Name(s) and departments of presenters
- Contact information for presenters (voicemail and email)
- Intended audience (department, faculty, staff)
- Room requirements (capacity, smart podium, computers)
- Date and time (every effort will be made to accommodate your request, unfortunately, this is not always possible)
