Guide 4: Library Resources in COMPUTER INFORMATION SYSTEMS

HOW TO FIND BOOKS IN THE LIBRARY

1. From any computer with Internet access, point the browser to the library web site [library.ccp.edu] and click on **CATALOG**. The Online Catalog can be searched by KEYWORD, SUBJECT, AUTHOR and TITLE.
2. From the menu select **SUBJECT**. Subject headings include:

COMPUTER ARCHITECTURE	ELECTRONIC DATA PROCESSING
COMPUTER INPUT-OUTPUT EQUIPMENT	INFORMATION NETWORKS
COMPUTER NETWORKS	LOGIC DATA PROCESSING

The New York Times Index [1851-present] An indispensable tool for locating information in the NY Times, as well as other newspapers. Provides a brief synopsis of the article.

Readers' Guide to Periodical Literature [1901-present] A cumulative index to periodicals, an excellent source for older periodicals not indexed in the electronic media.

Online Electronic Resources

EBSCOhost (Academic Search Elite and MasterFILE Premier) A database of over 3000 periodical titles, both popular and scholarly. *Articles published since 1990.*

Encyclopedia Britannica Online encyclopedia which gives **full text** articles pertaining to the topic of interest.

Ethnic Newswatch A **full text** database of local, national and international news, culture and history. Search interface is in both English and Spanish. Search by type of article. *Articles published since 1998.*

JSTOR A **full-text** database of backfiles of journals in fields such as history, economics, political science, mathematics, philosophy, etc. *Articles published in late 19th Century through 2001.*

Project MUSE A **full text** database of scholarly journal articles. *Articles published since 1990.*
