The Diane and George Davis Scholarship will provide three (3) scholarships of up to \$1,000 each disbursed equally over two semesters (fall 2009 and spring 2010). Qualified applicants must have earned 24 or less credits by the end of the spring 2009 semester and possess a minimum cumulative gpa of 3.0. Deadline: Monday, June 1, 2009.

The Philadelphia Inquirer/Daily News Scholarship will provide a maximum award ranging between \$500 and \$750 to full-time students who have earned a minimum of 24 credits. Applicant must reside in areas within the distribution of the Philadelphia Inquirer and Philadelphia Daily News in the greater Delaware Valley. Qualified applicants will have a cumulative gpa of 2.5. Deadline: Thursday, July 16, 2009.

The Book Award for Justice majors will provide one scholarship, with a maximum award of \$250, will be given to a student for the purchase of textbooks in the College's Bookstore during the fall 2009 semester. Students must have a minimum of 30 credits, nine of those credits in Justice courses, and a minimum grade point average of 3.0. Deadline: Monday, August 10, 2009.

The James R. Smith Memorial Book Award will provide up to \$500 for the purchase of textbooks at the College's Bookstore to a student pursuing his/her associate degree during the 2009/2010 academic year. Eligible applicants must have a minimum cumulative gpa of 3.0. Deadline: Monday, August 10, 2009.

The Greater Philadelphia Book Bank will provide up to \$500 for the purchase of textbooks at the College's Bookstore to two (2) students pursuing their associate degrees in Culture, Science and Technology, Science or Engineering Science. Recipients must be returning to the College for the 2009/2010 academic year and possess a minimum cumulative gpa of 3.0. Deadline: Monday, August 10, 2009.

The Dr. Edward Anderson Scholarship is available to full-time students who have completed 15 or less credits (as of December 2008) and are enrolled in one of the College's Business programs. Applicants must have a minimum cumulative gpa of 2.5. Deadline: Thursday, May 28, 2009.
