

International Student Services Placement Testing

Before being issued immigration documents or enrolling in classes, all students must satisfy placement. This measures skills in reading, writing, listening, speaking, and math to help determine your level of courses.

If you place at an ESL level, The College provides ESL courses that may be taken along with the academic courses. If you place <u>below</u> the minimum ESL level, you will not be able to enroll in courses and should meet with a member of ISS.

Placement Test Waiver

Some students may qualify for either a full or partial test waiver.

- 1. How to qualify:
 - a. Already have a college degree from an accredited U.S. college
 - b. Passed college-level English composition and/or mathematics courses with a C or better from an accredited U.S. college
 - c. Received the minimum scores on one or more of the following tests within the last 2 years:

i. IELTS: 6.0 Overall AND 6.0 in Writing iv. SAT English: 560 Writing iv. SAT Math: 510
 ii. TOEFL: 77 Overall AND 20 in v. ACT English: 21 Writing vi. ACT Math: 17

- 2. If you meet one of the above requirements, please send the official transcript or the test scores to by email to international@ccp.edu
- 3. You will be notified if you are waived from either the English and/or Math portion of the placement test and given further instructions regarding next steps

How to Take the Test - OVERSEAS STUDENTS

If you are not in the U.S., satisfy placement online with the ACCUPLACER test for overseas students

How to Take the Test -STUDENTS IN THE U.S.

If you are <u>inside the U.S.</u>, you may satisfy placement online with our real-time proctored test (if available) OR setup a test on campus at the Assessment Center (note: we will update all students on procedural changes related to COVID-19 safety measures)

- 1. Send an email to <u>assessmentcenter@ccp.edu</u> with the subject line "International Student Placement Test". In the body of the e-mail, please include:

 - c. Date of birth (mm/dd/yyyy)

 - e. Country of birth
