

International Student Services Financial Support Information

The United States government requires all international applicants provide proof of ability to pay tuition and living expenses before Community College of Philadelphia may issue an I-20. If you are relying on personal or family support, you must include provide documentation of financial support, stating your sponsor's name, address, and verifying the ability to pay your education-related expenses.

If your financial support is coming from your home government or other official agency (e.g., AMIDEAST or SACM), you must submit appropriate documentation from your sponsor.

Business, church or university sponsors must submit a financial statement on official letterhead that includes the following details: full name of student, relationship to student and amount of funding/support in lieu of the affidavit of support form. This should be submitted with the financial statement/bank document.

Acceptable evidence of financial support includes:

(Only original copies or certified/notarized copies are accepted)

- Bank statements indicating required currency amounts (issued within the last 6 months)
- Bank loans for educational purposes
- Scholarship letters
- Government funding
- Investments accounts where funds are available for immediate withdrawal

Unacceptable financial documents include

- Chartered accountant statements
- Payroll reports/expected income
- Tax statements
- Property assessments
- Credit card statements
- Bank statements lacking currency amounts
- Investment Accounts
- Other statements of non-liquid assets

Please be aware that you will not be able to pay for the full amount of your educational by working while you are in the U.S. Government regulations strictly limit employment and require that holders of student visas be full-time students. Therefore, job opportunities are extremely limited.
