**Community College of Philadelphia** is the largest public institution of higher education in Philadelphia, the sixth largest in Pennsylvania, and has served more than 865,000 individuals since the College began offering classes in 1965. Consisting of three regional centers in addition to the Main Campus, the College is an open-admission institution that provides the academic resources and support services needed to help students achieve their academic goals. 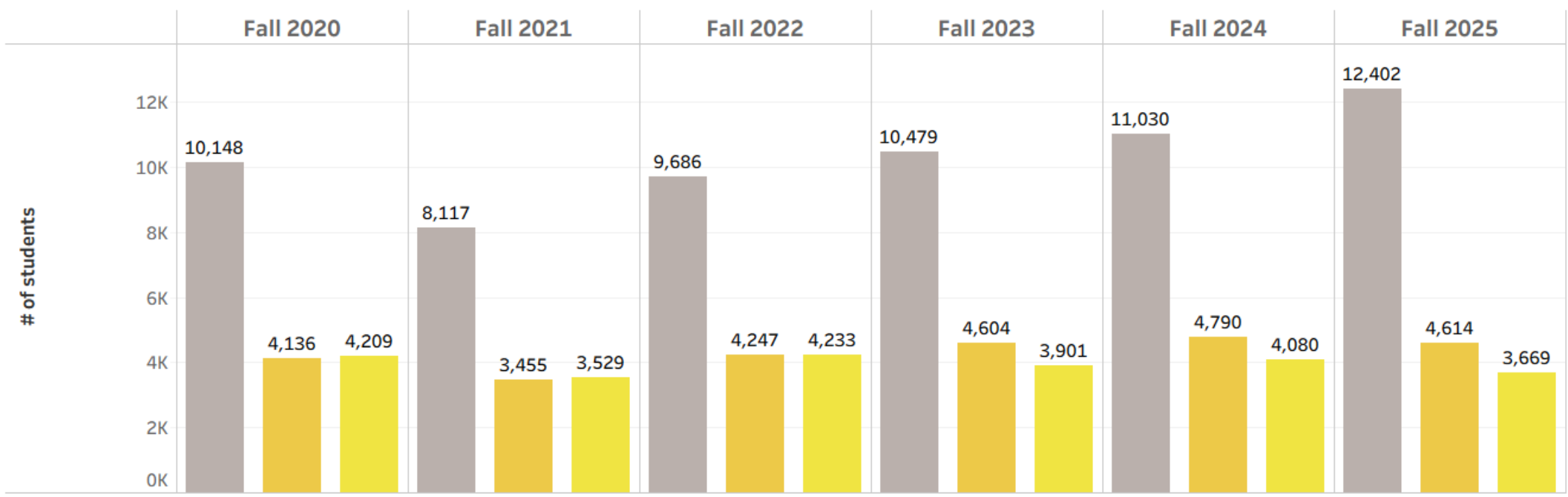


## Section 1: Applications

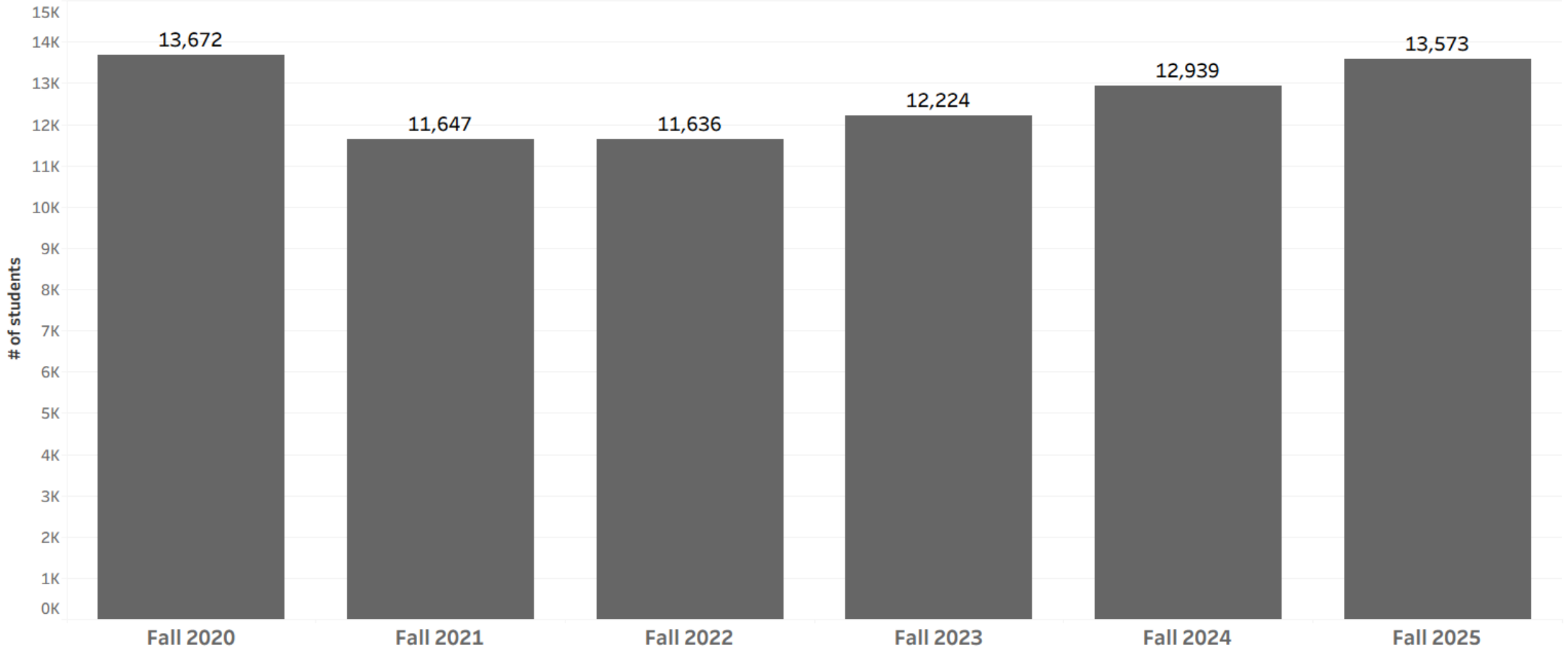

## 2.1: Total Enrollment by Fall Term

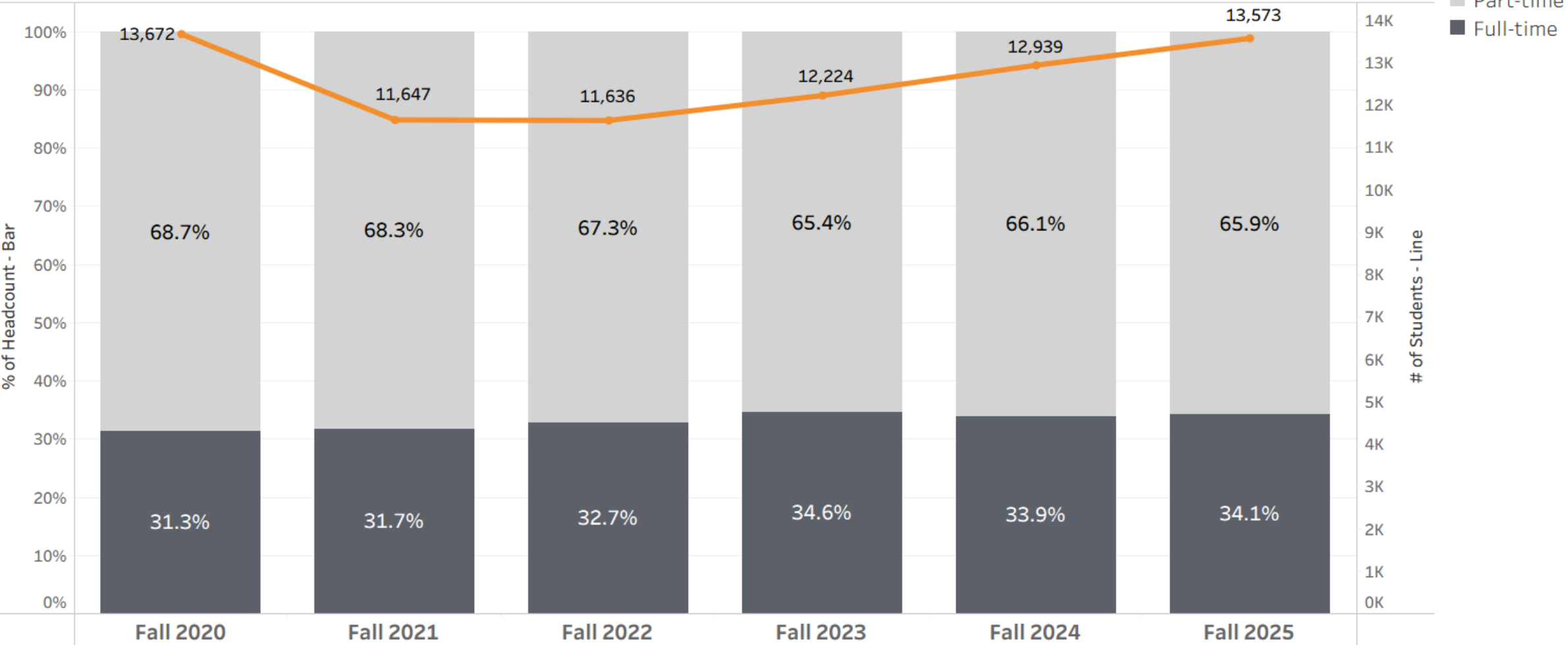

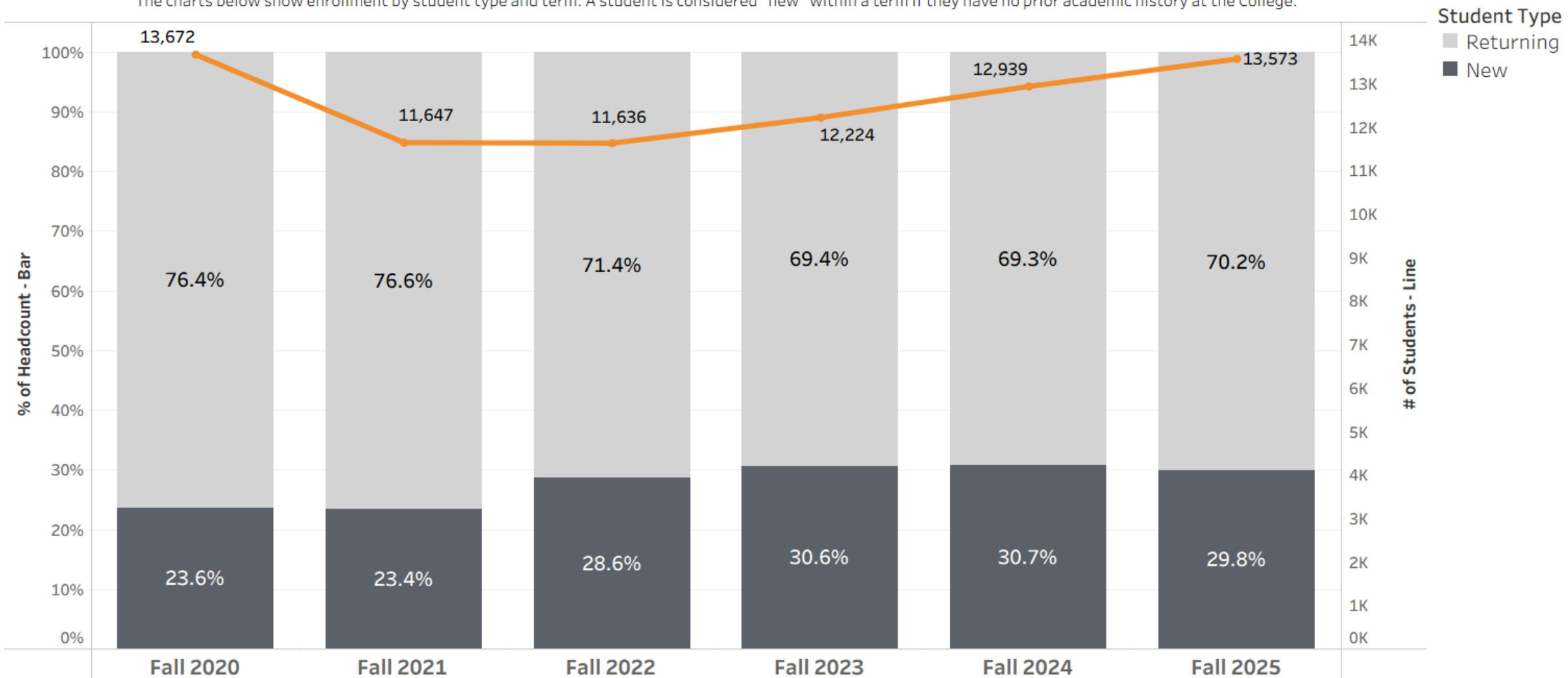

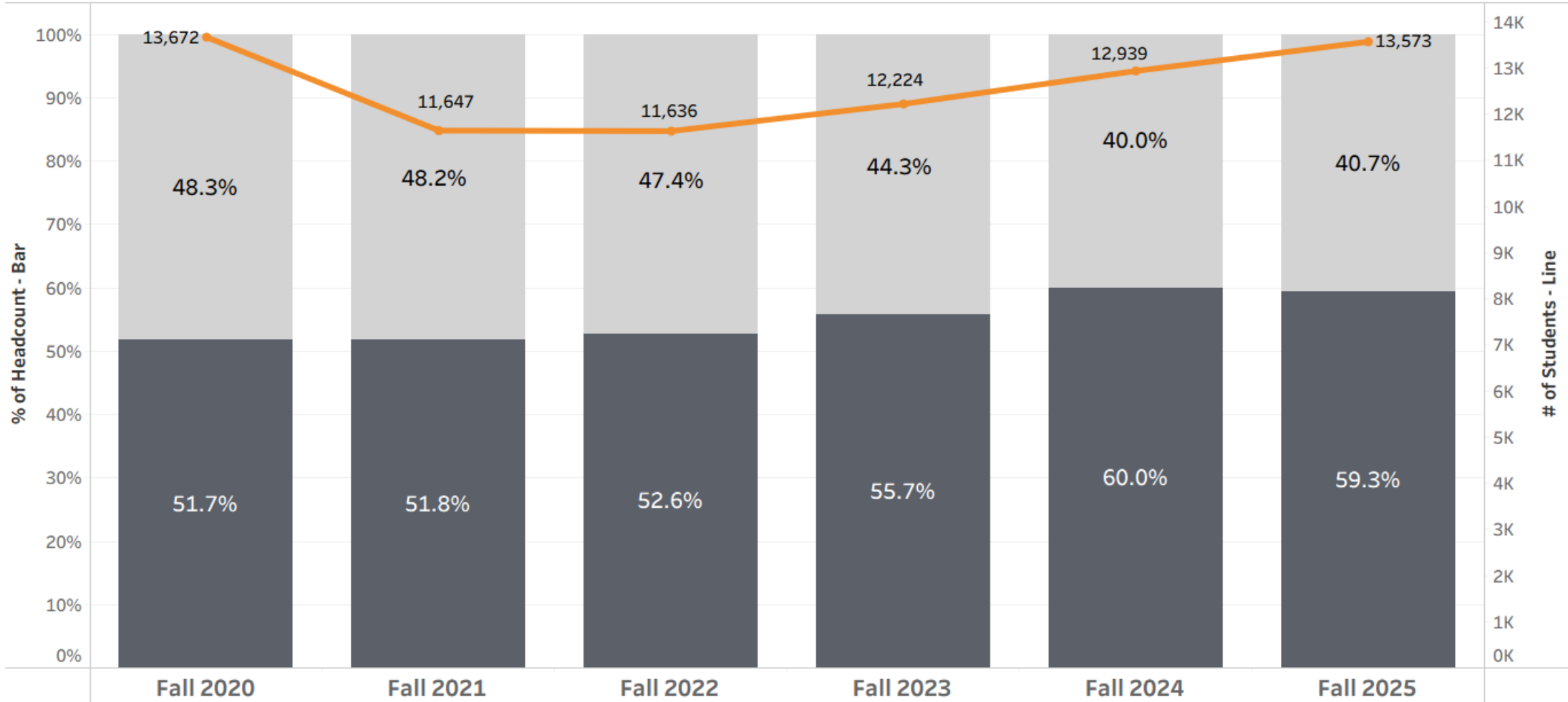

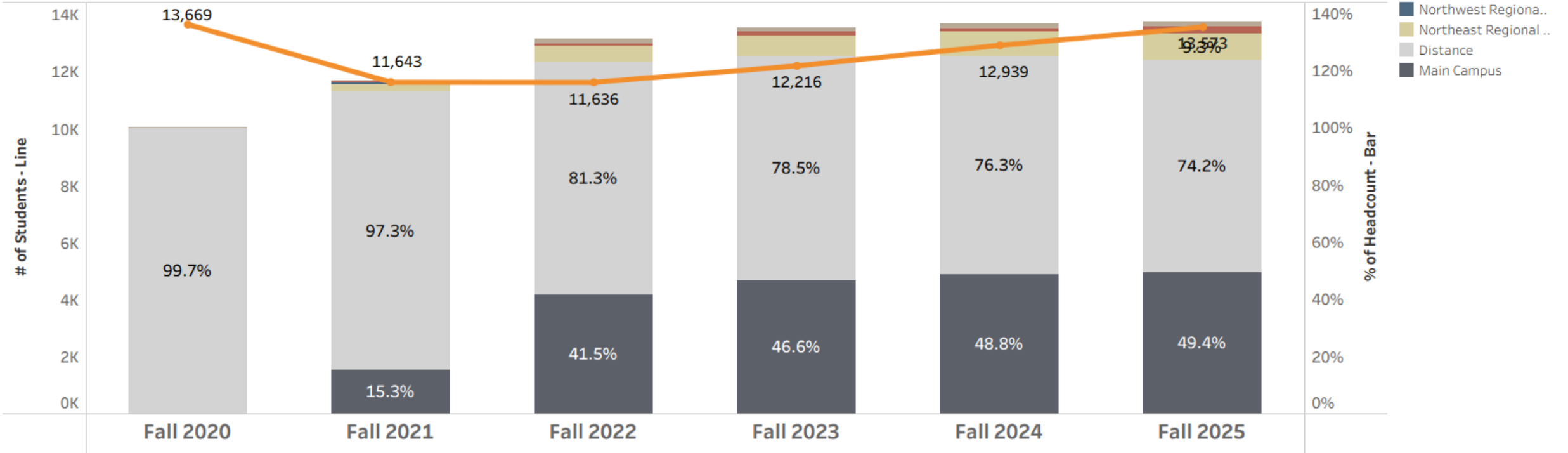

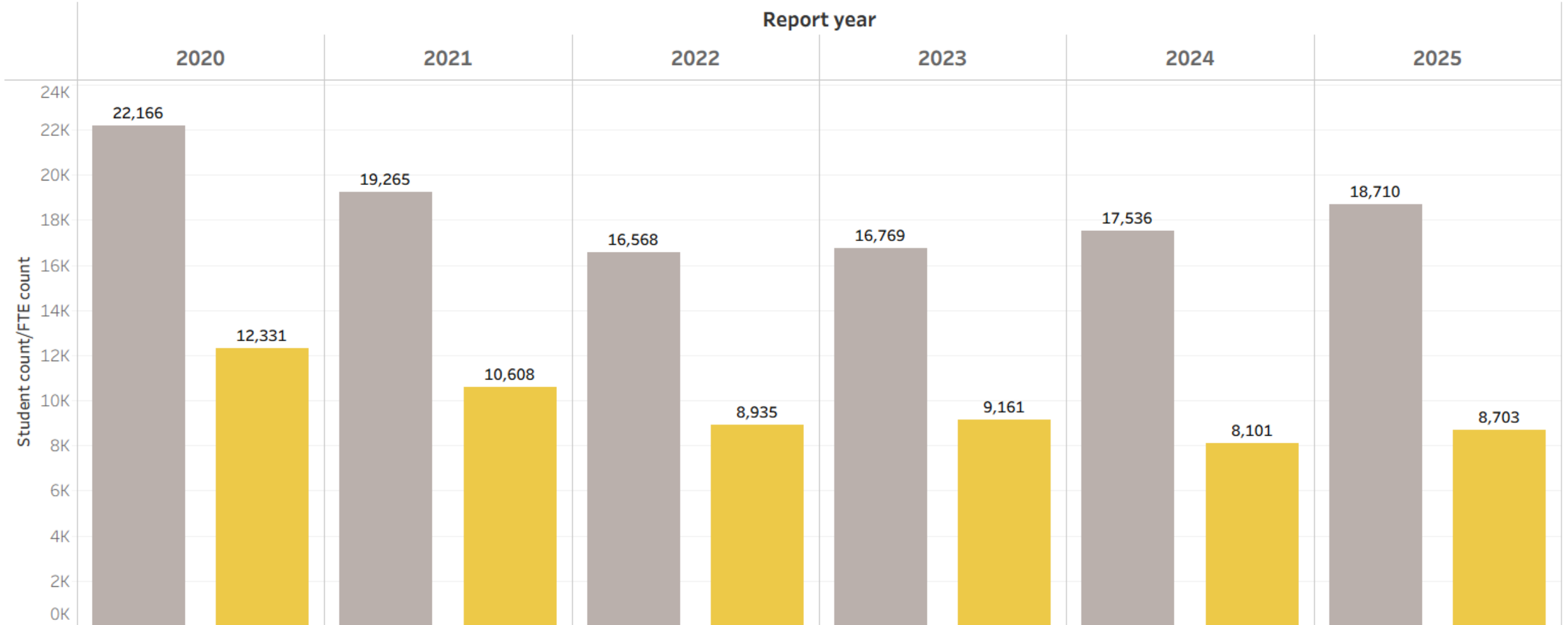

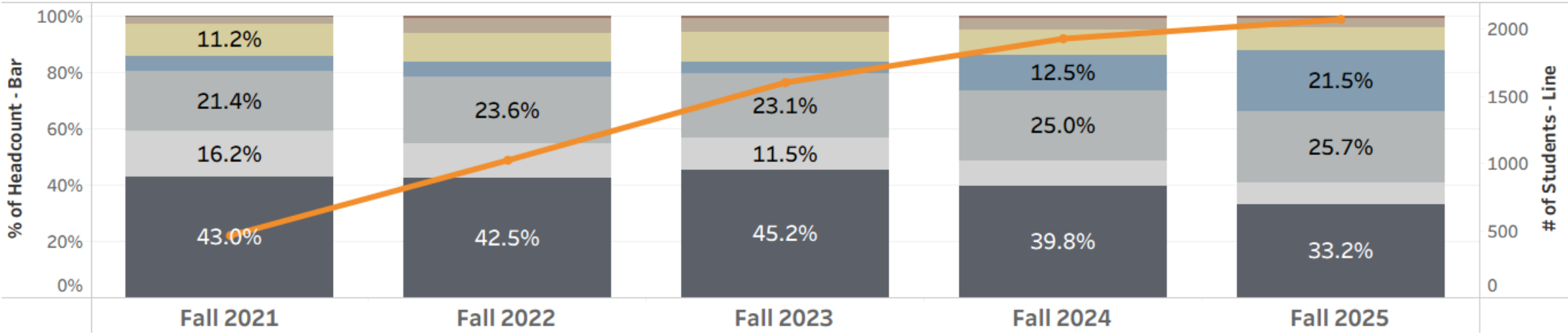

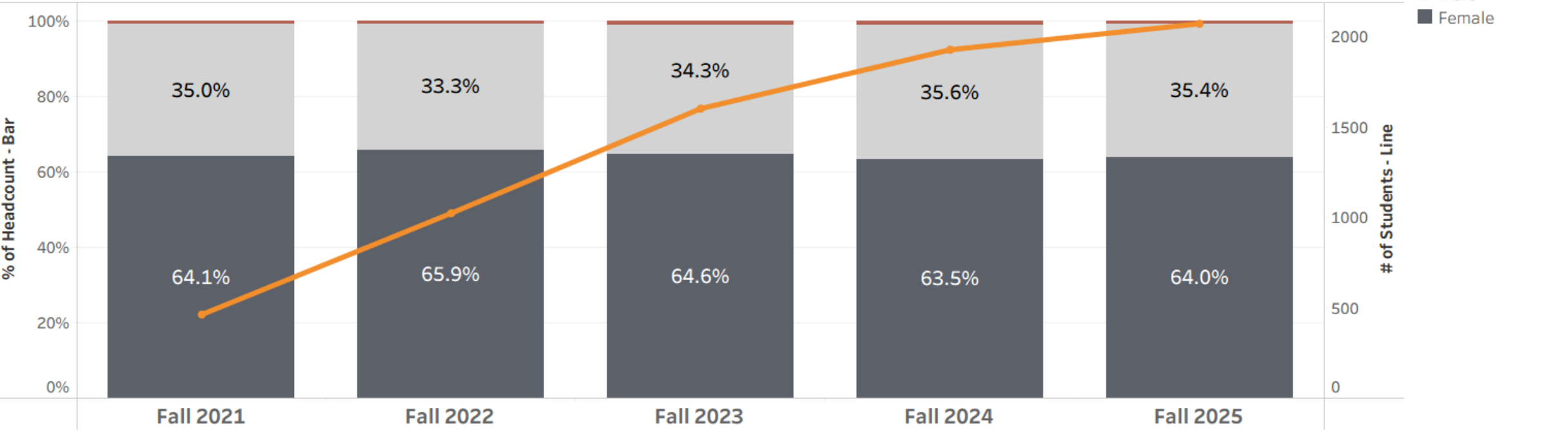

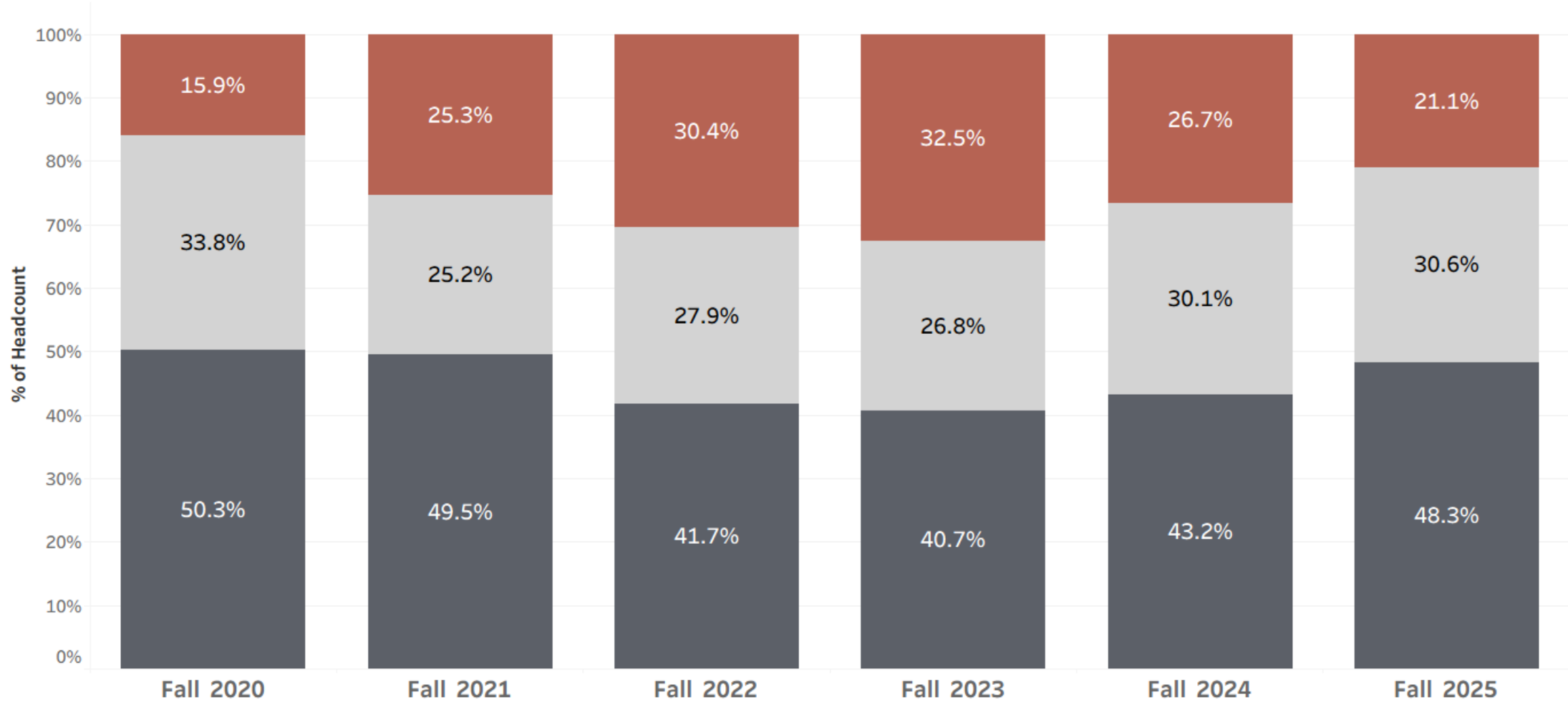

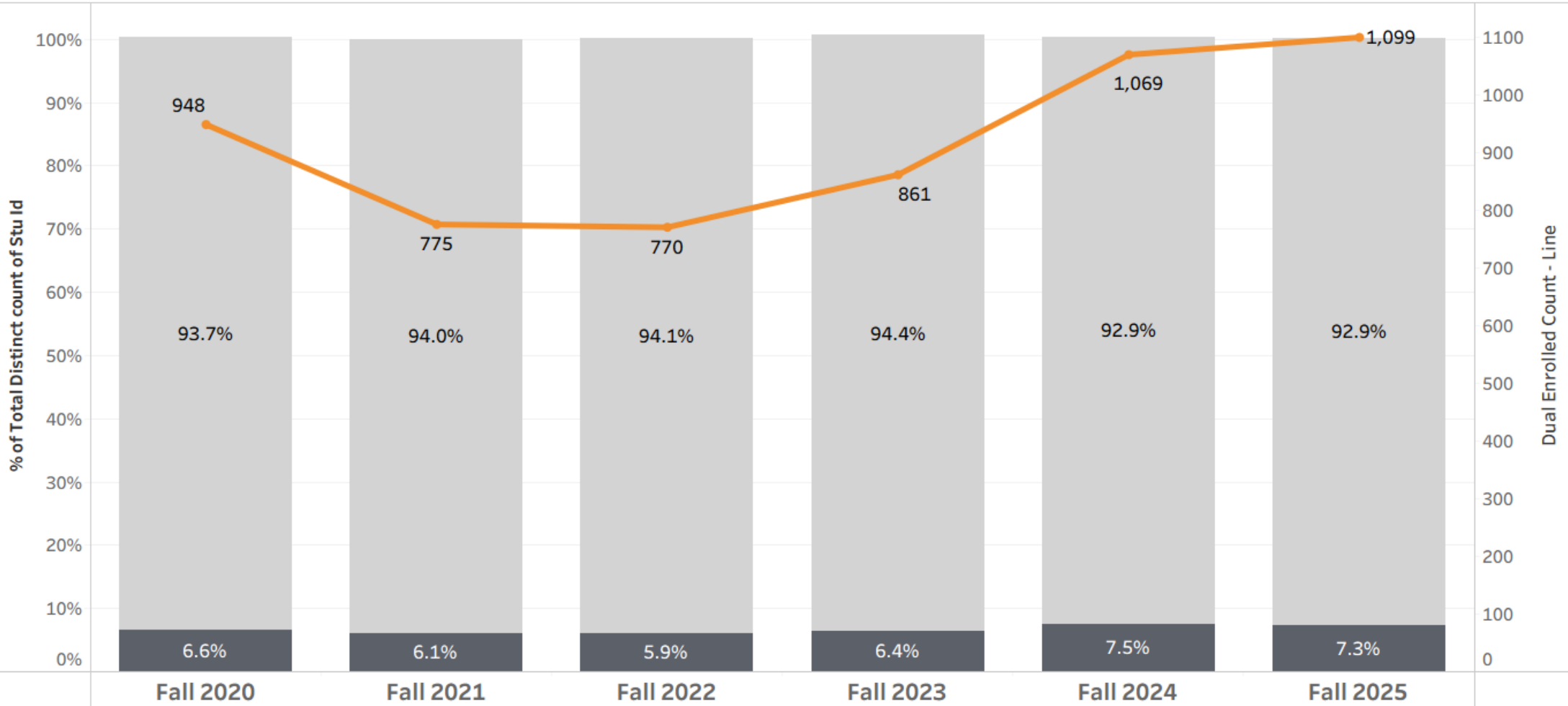

### 3.1: Graduation and Retention Rates

## 4.1: Human Resources

The table below displays the basic demographic information of College employees separated as the data is reported to the Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS). “Non-instructional staff” includes 12-month faculty such as librarians, counselors, advisors, and Learning Lab faculty.

FTE stands for “full-time equivalent” and converts part-time staff into measurements comparable to full-time staff. for example: a full-time employee equals 1 FTE whereas a half-time employee would equal 0.5 FTE.
