

Community College of Philadelphia is the largest public institution of higher education in Philadelphia, the sixth largest in Pennsylvania, and has served more than 865,000 individuals since the College began offering classes in 1965. Consisting of three regional centers in addition to the Main Campus, the College is an open-admission institution that provides the academic resources and support services needed to help students achieve their academic goals. It is hoped that the information provided on the following pages will give insight into the efforts of the College as well as guide decision-making to provide further educational opportunities to our students.




1.1: Applicants by Enrollment Status and term

Deffered Enrollment





















2.7: Enrollment by Pell Status and Term













2.17: Noncredit Enrollment by Race/Ethnicity and Term




2.18: Noncredit Enrollment by Gender and Term






